# “India Wins Yet Again”

Narendra Modi tweeted “India wins yet again” and said in his speech, “I bow to the 1.3 billion people of India. If someone is victorious, it is India. If someone is victorious, it is democracy. If someone is victorious, it is the electorate,” as the ruling BJP party swept back to power with 303 seats and 352 for NDA in the Lok Sabha, the lower house of India's parliament. This was made possible by registered voters of India's trillion people population where majority voters are women. Women also won highest ever seats in 2019 Elections.

Major shock came to India's Congress party of Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru, which was founded in 1885, for the second loss in a row. They campaigned on a secular and pluralist platform. The debacle comes with many lessons. Rahul Gandhi, of the Nehru-Gandhi dynasty and leader of India's Congress party is held responsible by default. He lost Amethi, their ‘sure win’ seat! Now Rahul's dynasty of great-grandfather, grandmother, father, uncle, mother and sister with high-profile political positions seems to be ending.

Several National parties fielded and tried to form coalitions to win collectively but the election was a Modi referendum. Modi's image is centered in his humble roots and his common man appeal. ‘This is termed the victory of the expectations of the honest citizen of India’. This election has also changed the very nature of Indian politics.

It's not just about the candidate, but he who dares to be different and focuses the narrative on changes within the country that could shape India not only the next five years of election, but, for the future of India, it's security as also foreign relations specially with USA, China and Pakistan. Path of growth of the economy, progress and prosperity of the Nation must be a visible vision not just mere word. Votes are cast with hopes for a healthy economy, availability of basic necessities for all, ease of doing business, better job opportunities, uplifting of livelihood, solutions for farmers problems, transparency of good governance, freedom from terrorism and corruption.

Every patriotic common man in India wishes for a stable, strong and wealthy India called “Sone Ki Chidiya” as it was once known! Modi show cases that and therefore he won, with what is being called an election tsunami!

# MODI GOVT 2.0: SPACE FLIGHT, SOLAR SHIFT IN 1,000-DAY PLAN



Prime Minister Narendra Modi will start his second stint not with a 100-day agenda, but a 1,000-day agenda that will run up to the first half of 2022, the 75th anniversary of India's independence, two people with direct knowledge of the matter said on condition of anonymity.

The plan will include several initiatives, from empowering women in agriculture to sending an Indian into space, as Modi seeks to fulfil his promise of creating a “New India” in his second term, they added.

“We have been directed to chalk out agenda for the first 1,000 days and the new ministers and department heads will have to frame a comprehensive strategy to meet these objectives by 2022,” said one of the people cited in the first instance, who works in a key government department.

A continuing emphasis on inclusive social welfare programmes, under the umbrella of “Antodaya” (upliftment of the poor), will run through the plan, the first person added. The emphasis on similar programmes, which benefited 220 million people (by the government's own count), is believed to be one of the factors responsible for the National Democratic Alliance's (NDA) re-election. Modi is understood to have directed his officials to go beyond the routine 100-day agenda and, instead, work on a comprehensive three-year strategy.

“The departments have been asked not to wait for the constitution of the new government, but to act immediately. After council of ministers is constituted, and portfolios allocated, they will start implementing the strategies in a mission mode, without wasting any time,” the second person said.

On Thursday, addressing party workers at the BJP headquarters soon after the election results came out, Prime Minister Modi said: “For the next five years, every Indian will have to pledge to transform India into a strong nation. The mission will require the same spirit as the one witnessed during the freedom struggle. We can make India a strong nation by 2022, before we complete 75 years of Independence.”

On Friday morning, BJP president Amit Shah met key ministers and told them to focus on fulfilling the agenda for 2022 with all seriousness, HT learns. “The new government is in no mood to waste any time and wants to act from day one,” the second person said. Some of the key schemes that will figure in the 1,000-day plan are: doubling farmer's income by 2022; setting up 40,000 MW rooftop solar projects ; housing for all; generating 100 GW solar energy; empowering women including farm workers, and launching India's first manned space mission, according to government officials who are working on Mission New India, as the plan is being tentatively called.

## 'Jilted' over lack of representation in Narendra Modi govt, Nitish expands Bihar cabinet to return 'one-berth' favour to BJP

Bihar chief minister Nitish Kumar expanded his cabinet on Sunday by inducting eight ministers. Otherwise a normal exercise and a prerogative of a chief minister, the timing and the manner in which only JD(U) lawmakers were made ministers ignoring ally BJP, has raised many eyebrows.

The sudden move by Nitish, also the president of JD(U), is being widely seen as a response to the development in New Delhi on Thursday (30 May, the day the

Narendra Modi government was sworn in) when Kumar's party decided to sit out of the government peeved with Modi's offer of just one ministerial berth to the JDU. Politely, but firmly, Kumar turned down the offer. He said that he was not miffed and even attended Modi's swearing-in to maintain the all-is-well optics. But within 48 hours of returning to Patna he hit back with the finesse of a political grandmaster that he is. Out of nowhere, Kumar called on the Governor Lalji Tandon on Saturday for expanding



his council of minister.

The numbers said it all: Eight ministers of JDU were sworn-in against the offer of one berth to ally BJP, which the latter unsurprisingly refused for now.

Nitish's deputy and BJP leader Sushil Kumar Modi, was silent and inaccessible. When pressed by the media for a reaction at the swearing-in ceremony, he just said. "Nitish ji had offered BJP for inclusion in his cabinet but the party felt that the vacancies can be filled later on." JD(U) sources say the induction of ministers became imminent after three of the ministers were elected to Lok Sabha. Already there were vacancies and the cabinet had only 25 ministers. There was still scope for three more ministers as per the limit of maximum 36 ministers.

LJP, whose single minister has been elected to the Lok Sabha, now has no representation in Nitish cabinet. The party was not even consulted, sources said. Party chief Ram Vilas Paswan, who has been retained in the Union government, was clueless but said it was not a big issue.

Nitish also skipped deputy chief minister's Iftar party on Sunday and instead organised a "hasty" Iftar thrown by his own party. The leaders may not admit that this could be the beginning of mistrust between the BJP and Kumar but the Bihar chief minister has already given hints through his media bytes and actions that he was not comfortable and definitely hurt with Modi's decision not to give more than one Cabinet berth to JD(U).

The growth of the BJP and its current political heft has put many regional satraps in the NDA in a highly uncomfortable position. Kumar is one of them but the JD(U) leader has shown courage and refused Modi's offer, unlike the Shiv Sena which has two more MPs than the JD(U) in Lok Sabha. Kumar believes that when the Assembly elections are held in Bihar next year, it will be his party taking the lead over the BJP in spite of the alliance.

Prem Kumar Mani, a close aide of Kumar during his political struggle days, feels that the Bihar chief minister had been humiliated but held Kumar responsible for this. "Sometimes a victory is worse than defeat. Kumar was a sad man despite a victory," said Mani. "Demanding proportional representation was unwise on part of Kumar."

## V Muraleedharan's appointment in Narendra Modi govt indicates BJP's grit to consolidate Hindu votes in Kerala after LS poll drubbing



The elevation of V Muraleedharan as a minister in the Narendra Modi government at the Centre shows that Bharatiya Janata Party's failure to win a seat in the Lok Sabha election has not deterred the party leadership from pursuing its mission to 'conquer' the southern state of Kerala.

The prime minister's decision to give the ministerial berth to a leader belonging to the majority community also reinforces the party's focus on a Hindu consolidation for making the much-needed electoral breakthrough in the state where it has been able to win only one Assembly in its electoral history seat so far. Modi had sought to attract the minorities by rewarding Alphonse Kannanthamanam, a Christian, with a ministerial position in his first term.

However, the bureaucrat-turned-politician failed to bring in the Christian community, which accounts for 18 percent of the state's population, close to the party. In fact, he could not ensure the support of the community for himself. Alphonse ended third in the Christian-dominated Ernakulam constituency with a vote share of just 14.24 percent.

BJP had shifted its focus to the majority community after faithful rose in protest against the Supreme Court verdict lifting the ban on menstruating women from entering the Lord Ayyappa temple at Sabarimala in Pathanamthitta district. The party had viewed this as a golden opportunity to increase its footprint in the state, where Hindus constitute about 56 percent of the population.

# Election win gave Narendra Modi political capital to enforce quick reforms; portfolio choices show presidential style of working

Narendra Modi's grand swearing-in as the Prime Minister of India was accompanied by two pieces of news on the economy — the first was that India's economic growth had fallen to a five-year low of under 6 percent, and that unemployment was at a multi-year high of over 6 percent; the second was that the new government will, within 100 days, deliver policies that will change India's labour laws (specifically meaning the ability of companies to easily fire workers).

The government also announced that it will acquire large plots of land that can be passed on to companies without agitations, such as the one in West Bengal's Singur against the Tatas for the establishment of a Nano plant. This is the sort of reform that would please investors, particularly foreign ones. The advantage the Bharatiya Janata Party has is that the massive mandate Modi secured gives him political capital to spend on significant reforms quickly. But the problem with such sudden, drastic changes is that there are opposing interests. For instance, the labour unions and political parties that agitate against such reform. This has prevented such changes in the past.

However, Modi's electoral sweep in the 2019 polls and total control of India's politics and his own party mean he has the space to deliver such changes, and quickly. We should expect to see them happen in the next few weeks. Today, let us look at the matter of the individuals who comprise the Cabinet Committee on Security — the prime minister and the four top Cabinet ministers. No one predicted these names — finance, home, defence and external affairs — correctly, showing how tight a control this government keeps on information.

Not even the media anticipated the selection of diplomat S Jaishankar as foreign minister. It can be seen as an extension of the presidential style of politics we have been told this election was about, like in the United States, where the Cabinet comprises experts handpicked by the president; they don't have to be elected. The ease with which Modi transferred individuals from one ministry to another indicates this style of working.

The prime minister personally provides the higher direction of the ministry, and the minister then works with bureaucrats on implementation. The choice of Jaishankar is interesting and unusual as he is an intellectual, a PhD-holder from a family of distinguished scholars. He will either have to change himself to accommodate the BJP's emotional approach to issues like relations with Pakistan, or he has been hired to change this approach. The former is the more likely guess. In the finance ministry, Nirmala Sitharaman received yet another promotion. She was given the defence minister's role in a surprise move in the last Lok Sabha, and now, she has one of the most important Cabinet positions. Sitharaman's placidity no doubt helped her progress.

Similarly, Rajnath Singh has been transferred to the defence ministry, a lateral move from home in terms of importance. It is these three ministries — external affairs, finance and defence — that Modi has taken most keen interest in running personally. Decisions such as the surgical strikes and the Balakot airstrikes have the stamp of his style, as well as the frequent visits to foreign locations and building personal relationships with leaders



such as Chinese president Xi Jinping and Israel's Benjamin Netanyahu.

However, it was the finance ministry that saw fewer changes after 2014 than businesses expected. When questioned about this in the past, Modi had said India had already carried out significant economic reforms, and that better governance, not policy changes, was the need of the hour. With the Modi 2.0 government's planned changes in labour and land laws, he will consider the process complete.

## BJP, Shiv Sena to contest from 135 seats each in Maharashtra polls, says Chandrakant Patil; calls Devendra Fadnavis 'natural choice' for CM



Mumbai: Saffron allies BJP and Shiv Sena will share equal number of seats in the upcoming Maharashtra Assembly elections, a senior BJP leader has said.

Talking to reporters here Saturday, Revenue Minister Chandrakant Patil also said Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis was the "natural choice" of the people, the BJP and the Sena for the top post again.

He said the two parties would contest 135 seats each in the 288-member House, and leave 18 seats for other allies. "Both Amit Shah and Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis had given a word that BJP and Shiv Sena will fight the assembly polls together. Our party doesn't go back on its word," Patil said.

"We have 122 sitting MLAs and eight independents are supporting the BJP, whereas

the Shiv Sena has 63 sitting MLAs. We will get only five additional seats," he said.

Fadnavis is the natural choice of the people, of the BJP as well as that of the Shiv Sena, he said, adding, the chief minister has balanced relations with Shiv Sena very well. "He has good equations with Uddhav Thackeray." "When 'Saamana' (Sena mouthpiece) wrote critical editorials, he would tell the party not to make their criticism public in the newspaper, but express it internally," Patil said.

In the recently-concluded Lok Sabha polls, the saffron parties together won 41 of the 48 seats. While the BJP secured 23 of the 25 seats it contested, the Sena managed victory in 18 of the 23 seats it fought.

Assembly elections in Maharashtra is scheduled to be held between September and October this year.





"India and China share a long-time friendly relations," he told PTI here. Asked about his reaction on Prime Minister Modi's victory in the 2019 general elections, Mu praised him and his efforts.

China on Friday said it attaches high importance to its bilateral relations with India and is keen

President Xi Jinping on Thursday skipped protocol and congratulated Modi even before the formal declaration of the poll results. In a first back-to-back majority in the Lok Sabha polls for a single party in over three decades, the Modi-led BJP won 303 seats out of 542 in the Lok Sabha polls, handing out a crushing defeat to the Congress and many other political opponents.

Islam is second largest Religion in INDIA with 12.2% of the country population or approximately 172 millions people identifying as adherents of ISLAM as per (2011 census). Indian muslim confronting the void political parties are no longer engaging with muslim like they used to. This process of withdrawal and fracturing began with the 2014 Lok Sabha election and Carrie's donon 2019 Election. This under-representation of muslim stems from the faster growing population, mainstream parties to give them tickets, In 2009 congress fielded 29 muslim candidate of whom 10 won in 2014, only 7 of the 31 congress muslim candidates won.

In 2019 there were 32 Muslim candidates among it's 464 candidates. Interestingly regional parties who bank on minority vote exhibit a small pattern of denial, for instance, there were only 10 muslims among the 70 candidates declared by the gathbandhan in UP, BSP 6 & SP 4, this is unlike previous election. BSP had 14 and 19 muslim candidates in 2009 and 2014. This denial of candidacy is denial of equal opportunity of this rights to take part in policy, law and discussion making bodies as citizen. There's no doubt that this indifference towards muslim has been caused by the triumph of Hindu right-wing populism. But we're polarisation and winnability not factors before 2013? No matter what form of government take majority muslim will remain play a major role to part of good and bad government. Although home to a Hindu majority, India has a muslim population 150 million, and increasing readily due to separate muslim law which allows to have 3 wife's and as many kids? Because muslim literacy rate rank well below and muslim poverty rate are

slightly higher as compared to hindu in india. Geographically no muslim in southern and western india trend to be better off the. ## Kurunegala doctor arrested; probe on assets

A Kurunegala Teaching Hospital doctor has been arrested over allegations that he had acquired a large number of assets through suspicious means, Kurunegala Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of Police Wasantha Kithsiri Jayalath said.

The suspect, who police identified as Seigu Siyabdeen Mohammed Shafi (42), is a resident of Gettuwana, Kurunegala. He is attached to the Kurunegala Hospital's gynaecology and obstetrics section, it is learnt.

He is a member of the All Ceylon Makkal Congress led by Minister Rishad Bathiudeen and had contested

the 2015 General Election on the UNP ticket from the Kurunegala District, but failed to get elected. He was arrested following an investigation into several police complaints that he had acquired a large number of assets in a suspicious manner, the DIG stated. The doctor was handed over to the CID for further investigations last evening.

Meanwhile, the Kurunegala Teaching Hospital is conducting an internal preliminary inquiry to determine whether there has been misconduct by a Medical Officer when performing Caesarian operations. "We are holding

a preliminary investigation, at the conclusion of which a report will be submitted to the Health Ministry," said the Kurunegala Teaching Hospital Director Dr. A.M.S. Weerabandara when contacted by the Sunday Times last afternoon.

Dr. Weerabandara said the police had informed him of the arrest of this Medical Officer and requested the hospital's support in their investigations on alleged health-related issues linked to this doctor. The director said that there had also been a complaint from the public about a name-change in a Mother's Card which

is usually filled up when an expectant mother comes for her delivery to the hospital. This is the card on which the newborn's birth certificate is based, it is learnt. Explaining that this complaint came about three weeks ago, he said that the hospital has concluded the preliminary investigation into this complaint and submitted the report to the Health Ministry.

Dr. Weerabandara, however, declined to confirm whether the Medical Officer who is now in police custody was implicated in the name-change complaint.

# New York Brokers Gaining Confidence in Early 2019, Says REBNY

The Real Estate Board of New York's latest Real Estate Broker Confidence Index for first quarter of 2019 is reporting a rising sense of confidence by New York City's local brokerage community with recording a 6.92 out of 10 index rating. This is an increase of 1.06 since brokers were last surveyed about the fourth quarter of 2018.

Residential and commercial broker confidence both experienced substantial increases in the first quarter of 2019 when compared to the previous quarter.

"Overall confidence among both residential and commercial brokers showed marked improvement from a year ago and reflects a positive outlook on the real estate market heading into the summer," said John H. Banks, REBNY President. "However, New York City brokers also expressed concern over the impact of recent policy changes and Albany's proposed rent reforms."

The Commercial Broker Confidence Index, which focuses only on responses from members of REBNY's Commercial Brokerage Division, was 7.24 in the first quarter of 2019, an increase of 0.78 since brokers were surveyed about the fourth quarter of 2018. Year-over-year, the index increased by 1.22, up from 6.02 in the first quarter of 2018.

More specifically, commercial brokers' responses regarding their current assessment of the real estate market and leasing conditions demonstrated optimism.

"Our economy is strong: companies are growing and profitable, are seeking talent in NYC, and people want to live and work in NYC," said one commercial broker.

Despite index improvements, commercial brokers expressed concerns about post-Amazon anti-business sentiments, commercial rent control, rent regulation reforms in Albany, interest rates, and office and retail vacancies.

"The negative attitude toward business, the pile on of taxes and fees, the restrictive environmental and rent regulations, etc., all harm the NYC commercial real estate market," said one commercial broker.

Another commercial broker addressed the shifting retail landscape in New York City saying: "With the impact of Internet-related sales, the use of retail space needs to be more creative and owners need to get more realistic."

The Commercial Broker Future Confidence Index, measuring brokers' expectations of the commercial market six months from now, grew to 6.69, a 0.85 increase compared to the previous quarter. This increase was fueled by heightened expectations for the financing and leasing markets.

The Residential Broker Confidence Index, which focuses only on responses from members of



REBNY's Residential Brokerage Division, was 6.59 in the first quarter of 2019, an increase of 1.34 since brokers were surveyed about the fourth quarter of 2018. Year-over-year, the index increased by 1.05, up from 5.54 in the first quarter of 2018.

Renewed confidence assessments of current residential market conditions, as well as the financing and leasing markets, accounted for the increase.
